


ANTI-SOCIAL CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014 Section 59

Public Spaces Protection Order Borough-wide

Basildon Borough, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of 3 years a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area, (outlined in the map below), where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area:



From (time)	0001	Hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	(year)	2025
To (time)	2359	Hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	(year)	2028

PROHIBITIONS:

Within the area described, the following are prohibited: -

- 1. Failing to comply with a direction not to consume, in breach of this order, alcohol, or anything which an authorised person reasonably believes to be alcohol where the authorised person reasonably believes that a person has engaged in anti-social behaviour.
- 2. Failing to surrender a container of alcohol (whether open or not) when asked to do so by an authorised person.
- 3. Urination or defecation in a public place unless such a place is a serviced public convenience.
- 4. Use of illegal drugs or psychoactive substances.
- 5. Use of a bicycle in a manner that causes or is likely to cause alarm, harassment, or distress to another person nearby, and failure to comply with a direction not to dismount when asked by an authorised person.

REQUIREMENTS:

A person who is believed to have engaged in a breach of this Order is required to give their name and address to a police officer, police community support officer or other person designated by the Council.
