

ANTI-SOCIAL CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014 Section 59

Public Spaces Protection Order Borough-wide

Basildon Borough, in exercise of its powers under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour Crime and Policing Act 2014, will be implementing for a duration of 3 years a Public Spaces Protection Order (PSPO), identifying a Restricted Area, (outlined in the map below), where the activities listed under PROHIBITIONS are prohibited and where a Police Officer, Police Community Support Officer or Authorised Council Officers have the power to require persons undertaking any of the restricted actions to cease forthwith.

Restricted Area:

Pitsea Town Centre



Festival Leisure Park/Mayflower Retail Park



Southfields Industrial Site



From (time) 0001	Hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	(year)	2025
To (time) 2359	Hrs (24 hour clock) on (date)	(year)	2028

PROHIBITIONS:

Within the area described, the following are prohibited: -

- 1. Car cruising in any of the locations identified as above, including;
 - a. Participation in car cruising or a car cruising event
 - b. Encouraging another person to participate in car cruising or a car cruising event
 - c. Congregating to watch car cruising or be in attendance to watch a car cruising event
 - d. Attending a car cruising event to supply or sell to those present any food, drink, goods or services.

REQUIREMENTS:

A person who is believed to have engaged in a breach of this Order is required to give their name and address to a police officer, police community support officer or other person designated by the Council.

THE EXCEPTION:

Nothing in this order shall apply to a person who is consuming alcohol on premises listed in section 62 of the 2014 Act, the full text of section 62 is set out at Schedule 3 of this Order.
