Whilst building on from their amazing work from the Winter Warmth 2019/2020 campaign, the LHERA has done further work with "The Bread Run" which saw them partner with a local church and were awarded the COVID-19 Response Grant to further aid those who were over 70, isolated, chronically ill, suffered with respiratory problems or fell seriously ill during Lockdown. The LHERA wanted to prioritise the residents knowing that there were people around willing to help them and the residents appreciated any help they received, especially during those first weeks when supermarket slots were harder to come by. Therefore, the LHERA and its volunteers assisted with shopping, pharmacy collections and other necessities. They have said that "residents appreciated having someone knock each week to check they were ok, have a little chat at their front door, albeit at 2 metres to keep them safe." The LHERA's tireless work has meant that they have delivered over 30 weeks of "The Bread Run" which they said would not have been possible without their volunteers. The LHERA then received a third grant to continue this project under the Surviving Winter Appeal Fund. They have also recently had the amazing news of receiving further funding awaiting release from the Essex Councillor Nomination Grant, and we can't wait to see the amazing work which they will do this year!
